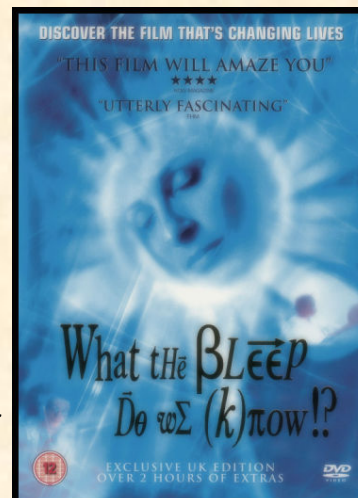


Mind Blowing Documentary – it's scientifically proven that your wishes do come true

- **DST Systems** (NYSE) – Information business. Employs about 10,500 people.
- **Novastar Financial** (NYSE) – Mortgage lender. Employs about 2,032 people
- **Applebee's** (NASDAQ) – Employs about 32,260 people.
- **Interstate Bakeries Corporation** (NASDAQ) – Largest wholesale baker and distributor of fresh bakery products in the US. It owns Hostess, Wonder Bread, Dolly Madison, Butternut Breads, and Drake's brands. Employs

about 25,000 people.

- **Great Plains Energy** (NYSE) – A holding company that owns Kansas City Power and Light Company which provides electricity for the city.
- **AMC Theatres** – The second largest movie theater chain in North America. Employs about 21,000 people.
- **Hallmark Cards** – Employs about 16,000 people.
- The French pharmaceutical company **Sanofi-Aventis** (NYSE) has one of the largest drug manufacturing plants in the United States and the plant is located in South Kansas City. Employs about 100,000 people.
- **Federal Reserve Bank headquarters** – Bills issued by the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City are marked with the letter "J" or the number "10." Employs 925 people in Kansas City.
